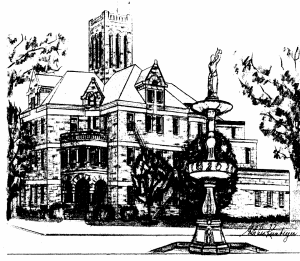

8:15 a.m. ACTION AGENDA:

The following subjects will be discussed, considered, and acted upon:

1. Approve Claims.
2. Final approval of Doehne Oaks, Unit One, accept Letter of Credit No. LC874 as road and storm water drainage improvements surety, accept dedication of 0.107 acres as public Right-of-way along State Highway 46, and grant variance request. (Pct. 1)
3. Consider and approve Order #191, authorizing the Disposition of Surplus Property.
4. Consider and approve Order #192, to Abate Nuisance at 2386 Candlelight Drive, declaring such property a public nuisance and authorize Purchasing Agent and County Engineer to take appropriate action to abate such public nuisance.
5. Consider and approve National Purchasing Partners Member Intergovernmental Cooperative Purchasing Agreement and authorize County Purchasing Director to sign.
6. Consider and approve the "Weapons Proficiency Program" for Certain Retired Law Enforcement Officers and Retired Federal Law Enforcement Officers for the Comal County Sheriff's Office.
7. Consider and approve a new School Officer position to begin August 17th, 2008, for Comal County Sheriff's Office. No budget item necessary.
8. Approve replacing three (3) Sheriff's Office Patrol Officers positions with three (3) Corporal Supervisory positions, one for each patrol shift. No budget amendment required.
9. Approve replacing two (2) Sheriff's Office Communications Officers positions with two (2) Assistant Supervisor positions, one for each shift. No budget amendment required.
10. Approve Tax Assessor-Collector's Monthly Collection Report – April 2008.
11. Discuss and consider refunds (over \$2,500.00) of ad valorem tax overpayments or erroneous payments and authorize the Comal County Tax Assessor-Collector to remit refund payments.

12. Approve a line-item transfer in Road & Bridge – Maintenance & Operations
From: Salaries To: Non-Capital Equipment, to cover the cost of a jackhammer for the Sign Crew.
13. **AUTHORIZE REQUESTING BIDS/PROPOSALS FOR:** Demi John Bend Road Reconstruction.
14. **EXECUTIVE SESSION** as authorized by Government Code Section 551.071 for Consultation with attorney.
15. **If necessary**, discuss and take appropriate action on any and all items or matters discussed in Executive Session.
