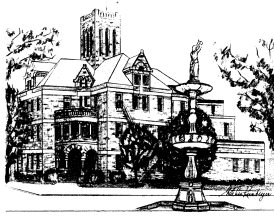

4. Approve Water Service Extension Agreement between New Braunfels Utilities and Comal County and authorize County Judge to sign.
5. Consider and approve Change Order to Bid 040-2010-400, Automated Flood Warning System for Low Water Crossings and authorize Purchasing Director to execute all related documents.
6. Discuss and consider waiver of penalties and interest accrued on 2009 ad valorem taxes and take appropriate action.
7. Authorize the County Engineer to waive permitting fees for the Homes for Our Troops project located at 610 Rittimann Road, being Lot 236, within the Crossing at Spring Creek, Unit Two. (Pct 4)
