Pretrial Bond Report 01/01/17- 12/31/17

1) The Comal County Pretrial Bond Program has released a total of 86 inmates from the County Jail in 2017 and placed them on Pretrial Bond Supervision. Of the 86 inmates, 8 were charged with Misdemeanors only, 51 were charged with Felonies only, and 28 were charged with both Felonies and Misdemeanors. Out of the 86 defendants released on bond supervision, 8 had been previously convicted of a felony within the six years prior to the date on which charges were filed in the matter pending during the person's release. During the 12-month period, the Pretrial Bond Department averaged 7 Bonds per month.

An additional 65 defendants were court ordered Pretrial Bond Supervision by District Court Judges as a condition of bond bringing the total to 151 defendants released and supervised by the Pretrial Bond Department in 2017.

Please refer to attached spreadsheet differentiating those offenders who were released by the Pretrial Supervision Officer, with the approval of the Court; and those offenders who were ordered Pretrial Bond Supervision by the Court after their release from custody while pending court action.

- ***Bond Supervision*** – A defendant on bond supervision is required to report to the Pretrial Officer as directed. The defendant is expected to submit to urinalysis as instructed and appear at scheduled appointments to discuss any possible bond violations. Bond conditions may vary depending on the originating offense and any risks that are identified after the completion of a risk assessment. The frequency of reporting is determined by potential risk factors to the community, as determined by the risk assessment, or as deemed necessary by the Court.

- 2) Provided within this packet is the statistical information of every bond granted in Comal County during Calendar Year 2017.

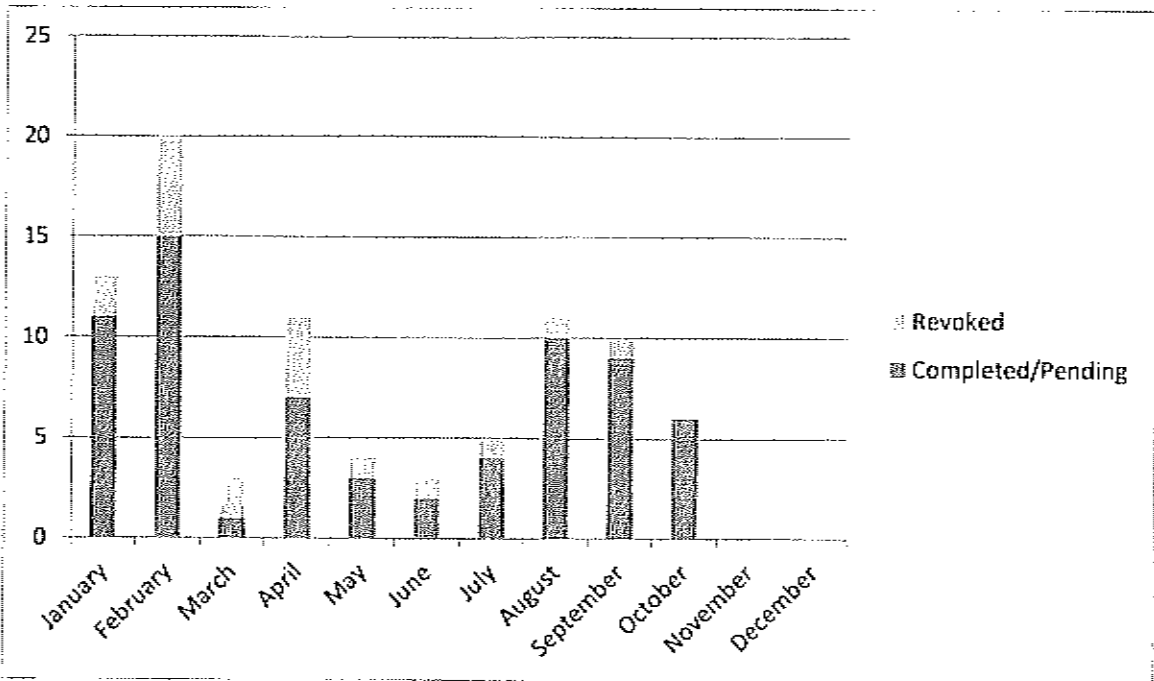


Figure 1: Outcomes by Month

- 3) Figure 1 contains the status of all cases that received Pretrial Bond Services in Comal County by month. There are many things included in this data. Here are some highlights:

- Out of **86** jail inmates who were released and supervised by the Pretrial Bond Program in 2017, three defendants failed to appear to court. This means the program had a 96.5% court-appearance rate.

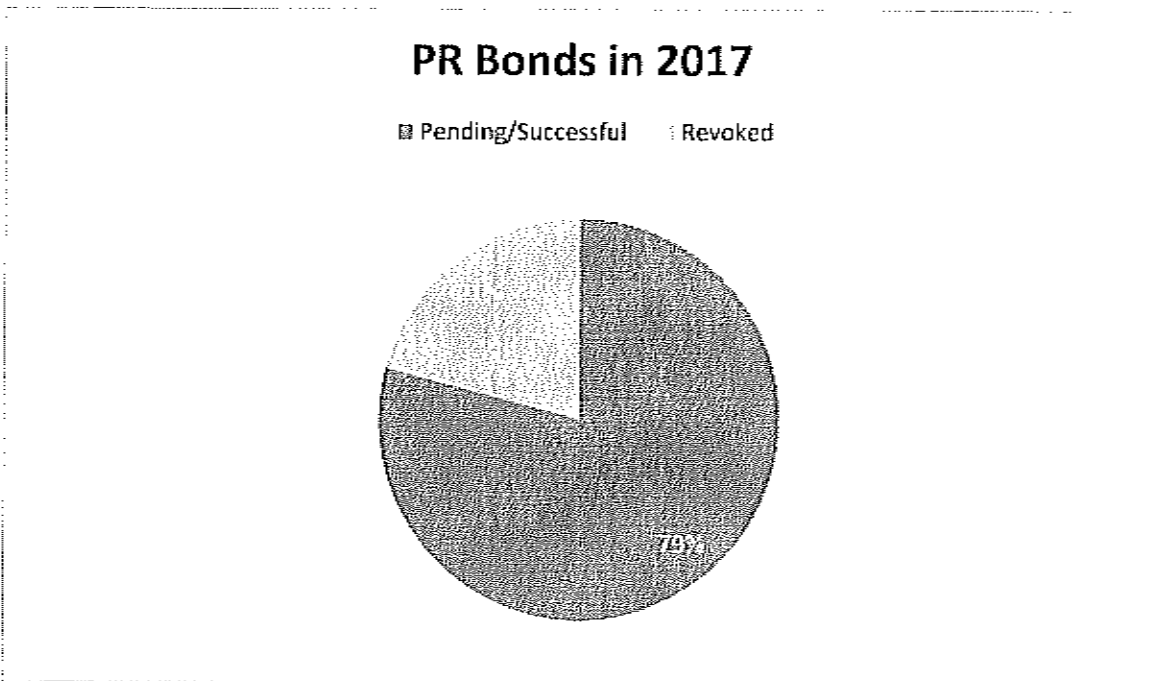


Figure 2: Outcomes for 2017

- Out of **86** total bond supervision defendants, **45** defendants have had a successful disposition or are currently in good standing.

- Out of **86** bond supervision defendants, **8** defendants violated conditions of their bond. Subsequently, the bond was revoked. The reasons for these revocations are outlined in the graph below.

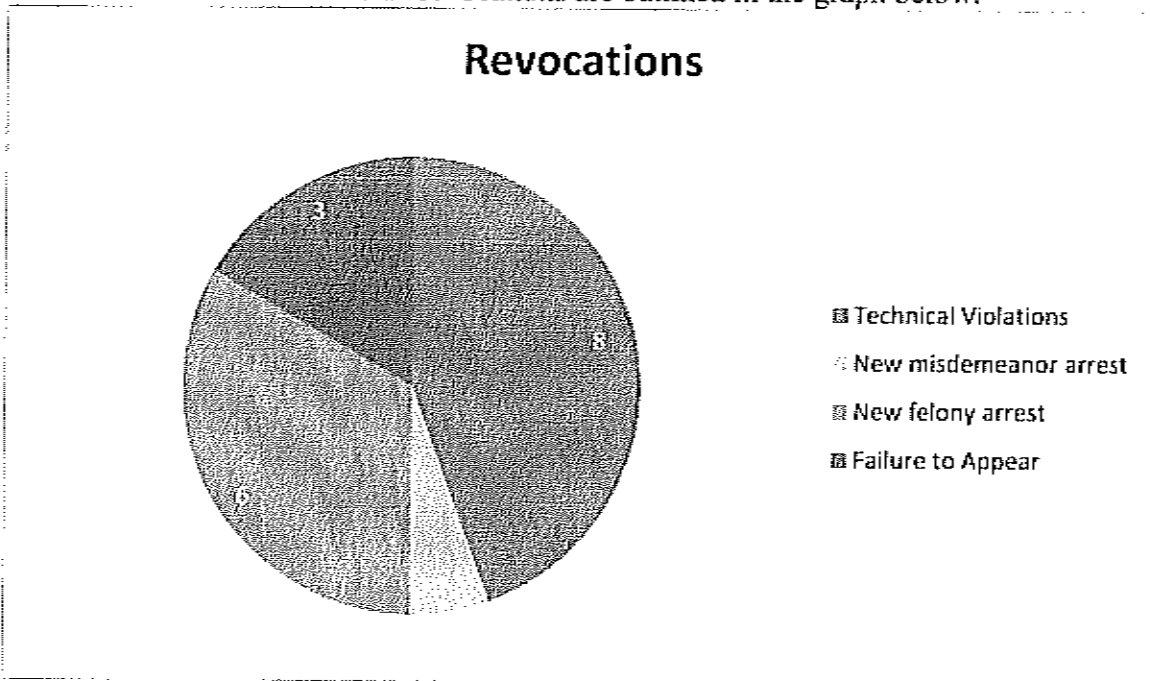


Figure 3: Reasons for Revocation

4) Financial aspects of the Pretrial Bond Program.

- According to the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure, Chapter 17, Article 17.42, Section 4(a), “the court shall assess a personal bond fee of \$20 or three percent of the amount of the bail fixed for the accused, whichever is greater. The court may waive the fee or assess a lesser fee if good cause is shown”. These funds help defray the cost of program operation. The amount of bond is ordered by the District Court Judges, County Court at Law Judges, or the Magistrates of Comal County.
- The target audience for the program is the defendant who cannot afford to make bond with a traditional bond company. These companies usually charge approximately 10% of the total bond amount.
- During the specified dates of 1/01/17 – 12/31/17, Comal County CSCD has collected \$4,090.00 in assessed bond fees. These funds are deposited into the County Treasury.
- During the specified dates of 1/01/16 – 12/31/16, Comal County CSCD has collected \$2,965.00 in bond supervision fees. These fees are assessed on defendants released onto Bond Supervision by District Court and County Court at Law Judges.
- During the specified dates of 1/01/16 – 12/31/16, Comal County CSCD has collected \$1,285.00 in drug testing fees in Bond Supervision cases. Defendants

are charged a one-time fee of \$25.00 for misdemeanor cases and \$50.00 for felony cases.

- 5) The Pretrial Bond Program has also directly affected the operating cost of the Jail.
- The capacity of the Comal County jail is approximately 337 inmates. The jail population averaged 355 jail inmates in 2017. The Pretrial Bond Program releases approximately 7 inmates per month. In 2017, Comal County Jail reached capacity, and utilized other jails to house Comal County inmates. It costs an estimated ***\$83.54** per day to house an offender at the Comal County Jail. When an inmate is transferred to another facility for housing, that cost is increased. The following is not an exhaustive listing but are contributors to the increased cost: other jurisdictions charge varying amounts to hold an inmate, the cost of fuel and wear and tear on a vehicle to transport a defendant to and from the other facility, the cost for the employee of the Sheriff's Office to provide the transport, and the cost to schedule additional employees to provide services at the Jail and/or transport that would otherwise not be necessary. Ancillary additional costs that are born by the County and/or other agencies/entities when a defendant is housed at another facility while pending sentencing include but are not limited to the following: the additional cost for a Court-appointed attorney to visit a defendant at another facility, the additional cost for a community supervision officer to travel to another jurisdiction as part of the preparation of a pre-sentence investigation report, the cost of any medical attention needed for a defendant while housed at another facility, the cost for administrators at each jail to coordinate transportation and other services, and the cost to the defendant's family to visit the inmate.
 - ***\$83.54 is based on information from the Fiscal Year 2017 Comal County Jail Budget as provided by Major John Bell with the Comal County Sheriff's Office.**
 - It is difficult to determine the exact amount of time that it would take for the **86** offenders that were given bonds to be released from jail. Texas Code of Criminal Procedure Chapter 17, Article 17.151 (Release Because of Delay) states that defendants are required to either be released on a personal bond, or have their bond reduced if the State is not ready for trial of the criminal action for which the defendant is being detained, after 30 days for a Class A Misdemeanor, 15 days for a Class B Misdemeanor, and after 90 days for any Felony.
 - By placing defendants on Bond Supervision prior to these time frames, the county is able to save funds related to the cost of incarceration. The chart below details the amount of funds used to house 86 inmates if they were to be detained for the entire length of time allowed by statute.
 - **NOTE:** These timeframes do not apply to a defendant who is serving a sentence of imprisonment for another offense while the defendant is serving that sentence, being detained pending trial of another accusation against the defendant as to which the applicable period has not yet elapsed, incompetent to stand trial, during the period of the defendant's incompetence, or being detained for a violation of the conditions of a previous release related to the safety of a victim of the alleged offense or to the safety of the community.

6) Pretrial Bond Supervision is also available in Comal County through bond conditions ordered by a County Court at Law or District Court Judge. In this circumstance, the defendant is released on bond, pending a case disposition. These are offenders that the Court requires supervision while their case is pending. This provides extra protection to the community and information about the defendant that would otherwise be unavailable to the Court.

7) Included with this report is an example packet of a typical Pretrial Bond Defendant. This example will illustrate what the Judges are taking into consideration in regards to granting a personal bond.

8) Along with the Pretrial Bond Program the Comal County CSCD assists with the operation of a House Arrest Program. The House Arrest Program was established in January 2010 by the Honorable Charles A. Stephens, II, who presides over Comal County Court at Law #2. The Honorable Randy Gray, Presiding Judge of Comal County Court at Law #1 also orders defendants to this Program.

- From January 1, 2017 to December 31, 2017 there were 16 offenders placed on the House Arrest Program. Out of the 16 offenders placed on the House Arrest Program one offender violated the rules of the program and was placed back into the Comal County Jail. This equates to a total of 1,150 days saved from the jail. At \$83.54 per day, per inmate, it was an approximate of \$96,071.00 in savings for the jail.

9) The Pretrial Bond Supervision Officer also supervises Orders on Conditions of Bond that include a Condition for an Ignition Interlock Order. These Conditions are ordered by Magistrates, County Court at Law Judges, and District Court Judges. The current number of active devices that are being monitored is 111. The supervision of these devices includes ensuring installation of these devices, monitoring monthly reports, preparing violation notices if necessary, and reporting these violations to the Judges of Comal County.
