ORDER 263 ON 2010 TAX RATE


WHEREAS § 26.05(b) of the Texas Tax Code States "a taxing unit may not impose property taxes in any year until the governing body has adopted a tax rate for that year, and the annual tax rate must be set by ordinance, resolution, or order, depending on the method prescribed by law for adoption of a law by the governing body. The vote on the ordinance, resolution, or order setting the tax rate must be separate from the vote adopting the budget."

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by Commissioners Court of Comal County that the 2010 Comal County Property Tax Rate be increased by the adoption of a tax rate of \$ 0.334000 (\$ 0.259763 for General maintenance and operations, \$ 0.029237 for debt service and \$ 0.045000 for Farm to Market and Lateral Road maintenance and operation) per \$100 of valuation, which is effectively a 3.693217 percent increase in the tax rate.

THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE.

THE TAX RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE RAISED BY 3.693217 PERCENT AND WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$100,000 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$22.10.



