RESOLUTION #2011-17
ADOPTING GUIDELINES AND CRITERIA FOR TAX ABATEMENTS AND APPOINTING MEMBERS TO THE COMAL COUNTY TAX COMPLIANCE COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, in May 2001, by Resolution 2001-08, the Commissioners Court of Comal County adopted guidelines and criteria to tax abatement agreements in accordance with Texas Tax Code §312.002; and

WHEREAS, the guidelines and criteria adopted under this section are effective for two years from the date adopted; TEXAS TAX CODE §312.001; and

WHEREAS, on April 7, 2011, the Commissioners Court of Comal County approved an Application for Tax Abatement/Economic Development Incentives (“Application”) and amended the Resolution #2001-08 Adopting Guidelines and Criteria for Tax Abatements to assess an application fee of \$500.00; and

WHEREAS, Comal County continues to believe it to be in the public interest to resume its current tax abatement policy as currently amended including the Application and application fee of \$500.00; and that job retention and expansion of primary employment and attraction of major investment would occur and contribute to the economic development of Comal County; and

WHEREAS, a tax abatement policy provides a valuable economic tool for use by the County and others interested in supporting and creating jobs in Comal County; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Commissioners Court of Comal County, Texas, duly convened and acting in its capacity as the governing body of Comal County, hereby adopts Resolution 2001-08 which establishes the guidelines and criteria for tax abatements, as amended including the Application and application fee of \$500.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Commissioners Court of Comal County appoints to the Comal County Tax Abatement Compliance committee Scott Haag, Commissioner Precinct 2; Gregory Parker, Commissioner Precinct 3; David Renken, Comal County Auditor; Cathy C. Talcott, Comal County Tax Assessor-Collector; Curtis Koehler, Comal Appraisal District; Rusty Brockman, New Braunfels Chamber of Commerce Economic Development Director; Tiffany Colunga, Chief Civil Assistant District Attorney; and Ramona Womack, Comal County Purchasing Agent.
