



COMAL COUNTY EXECUTIVE ORDER #397



RESTRICTING USE AND ACCESS OF GUADALUPE RIVER IN COMAL COUNTY, TEXAS


WHEREAS, Comal County Judge Sherman Krause declared a local state of disaster for Comal County, Texas pursuant to section 418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code; and

WHEREAS, there is an imminent threat of flash flooding and high winds resulting from Hurricane Harvey, which poses a significant risk to the health, safety, and welfare of the public.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE OF COMAL COUNTY, TEXAS:

1. That a person shall not enter for any purpose, including but not limited to recreational use, the Guadalupe River from Guadalupe State Park downstream to the city limits of New Braunfels, Texas.
2. This order shall not apply to a person authorized by local government officials, including property owners and their designated tenants, persons assisting in the protection of the health, safety, or welfare of the public, and persons authorized by local or state government officials for the provision of restoration and rehabilitation of property affected by this disaster.
3. This order shall be effective as of 5:00 p.m. of the date of signing and continue for a period of not more than six days from the date of this order unless continued or renewed by the Commissioners Court of Comal County, Texas.
