Law Library to close for relocation

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE, DECEMBER 8, 2017:

NEW BRAUNFELS — The Comal County Law Library will be closed for two weeks to relocate across the street and clear the way for renovation of the county's Landa Building in downtown New Braunfels.

The Law Library, currently on the first floor of the Landa Building, 178 E. Mill St., will move beginning Monday, Dec. 11. It will reopen inside the Juvenile Probation Department, 171 E. Mill St., Room 130, on Wednesday, Dec. 27.

The library's reading room is open 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday; it will be housed in Juvenile Probation while the county renovates its downtown office and courtroom facilities. The Law Library's permanent home will be determined at a later date.

The Landa Building is the 45-year-old former First Federal Savings and Loan building located on the site of the former Landa family mansion next to the historic Comal County Courthouse. The Landa Building was first converted into county offices in 1992 and last underwent significant renovations in 2002.

Renovations on the facility and the Comal County Annex are expected to last into 2020.
