Summer seal coating to resurface dozens of county roads

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE, JUNE 28, 2017:

NEW BRAUNFELS — Dozens of roads in subdivisions spread throughout Comal County will receive a new seal coat this summer.

As part of the county's annual seal coat program, contractor Fuquay Inc. will resurface 41 miles of roads in the following subdivisions:

- Oak View, south of FM 1863 near SH 46
- Tom Creek Hills, west of Startzville
- The Point at Rancho del Lago, west of FM 3424
- Sattler Village and River Valley Estates, south of Sattler Road
- Bracken, near FM 2252 at the county line
- Bulverde Estates, west of U.S. 281
- Canyon Lake Island
- Cypress Cove and part of Mystic Shores, between FM 306 and the Guadalupe River

Seal coat resurfacing also will include the following roads:

- Blanco Road
- West Ammann Road, from Blanco Road to Georg Oaks

The project is expected to begin by June 30 and be complete by the end of September. Additional seal coating and road preparation by county crews will continue throughout the summer.

“Comal County’s annual summer seal coat program helps extend the life and improve the drivability of county-maintained roads,” said County Engineer Tom Hornseth. “We don’t anticipate major disruptions, but we do appreciate residents’ patience and consideration if they encounter any delays over the summer.”
