Extension Office, naturalists to celebrate Earth Day at Canyon Lake

NEW BRAUNFELS — Comal County residents are invited to celebrate Earth Day with the county's extension office and the Lindheimer chapter of the Texas Master Naturalists.

The two groups are co-hosting an Earth Day celebration from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. Saturday, April 22, at Tye Preston Memorial Library, 16311 S. Access Road, Sattler.

The event will include hands-on activities for kids; a bat display by the Bracken Bat Cave and Old Tunnel Texas State Park; education about native grasses, rainwater collection, beekeeping and more; and face- and dirt-painting.

The Earth Day celebration is free and open to the public, said Troy Luepke, extension agent for agriculture and natural resources.

“Earth Day is a terrific opportunity for families to have fun together and learn more about how we can better steward our natural resources,” Luepke said. “This celebration is a great way to do both of those things.”
