County initiates new bidding process with Texas Purchasing Group

NEW BRAUNFELS — Comal County is changing the process by which potential vendors can bid on projects as part of its move to join the Texas Purchasing Group, a regional purchasing community run by BidNet.

As part of the new process, vendors are asked to register online with the Texas Purchasing Group to access Comal County's upcoming projects.

"We're always looking for ways to become more efficient and save taxpayer dollars," said Ramona Womack, the county's purchasing director. "Texas Purchasing Group gives us an opportunity to do that by expanding our reach and connecting us with vendors and other communities throughout the state."

Along with a variety of bid and vendor management solutions, Comal County gains access to a bid library to help with bid creation, a shared pool of vendors, and association with like-minded purchasing professionals in the area. Texas Purchasing Group also provides electronic document distribution and activity tracking through the procurement process.
