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Property taxes due to county Wednesday

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE, JANUARY 24, 2018:

NEW BRAUNFELS — The deadline for Comal County property owners to pay their property taxes is Wednesday, Jan. 31. Beginning Feb. 1, all unpaid taxes will begin to accrue penalties and interest.

All payments are due to the Comal County Tax Office.

“We offer many convenient methods to pay your taxes so you don’t have to wait in line,” said Cathy Talcott, the county’s tax assessor-collector. “I encourage taxpayers to utilize our mail-in or online payment options to save themselves time.”

Residents have several payment options for their property taxes:

- Online at comalcountytaxoffice.net;
- By automated phone at 866-550-0031;
- By scanning the QR code on the statement with a mobile device;
- By mail to P.O. Box 659480, San Antonio, TX 78265, postmarked no later than Jan. 31;
- By walk-up or drive-through drop boxes located at
 - Comal County Tax Office, 205 N. Seguin Ave., New Braunfels,
 - Canyon Lake branch office, 160 Oak Drive, Sattler,
 - Bulverde branch office, 30450 Cougar Bend, or
 - Garden Ridge City Hall, 9400 Municipal Parkway; or
- In person to the tax offices in New Braunfels, Sattler or Bulverde. Hours are 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. at all three offices; however, the New Braunfels office will stay open until 5 p.m. on Jan. 31 to accommodate the extra traffic.

Residents also can view and print statements and receipts from the Tax Office website. To get a receipt with a mailed-in or dropped-off payment, include a self-addressed stamped envelope.

The Tax Office also accepts partial payments, although penalties and interest will begin to accrue on any balance unpaid by Feb. 1. Property owners with additional questions should call the Tax Office at 830-221-1353.

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
