DIY Saturday to focus on fairy gardens

NEW BRAUNFELS — Comal County residents and their children will be able to bring fairies to life as part of the next DIY Saturday from the county's office of the Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service.

The class will focus on fairy gardens – tiny setups created with miniatures that provide a unique, therapeutic way to tend plants year-round. The class will be 9-11 a.m. Saturday, March 10, at the Comal County Extension Office, 325 Resource Drive, New Braunfels. The cost is \$20, and supplies will be provided. The deadline to register is Wednesday, March 7.

“Fairy gardening is great fun for the whole family,” said Krystal Snider, Comal County extension agent for health education. “It also reduces stress and is an economical and water-efficient way to garden, so we encourage everyone who is interested to come out and learn how to make their own.”
