Custom rates survey helps landowners know market

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE, JUNE 1, 2018:

NEW BRAUNFELS — The Comal County office of the Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service is asking local farmers and ranchers to help provide a better picture of what they pay or charge for various operations on their land.

The 2018 Texas Custom Rates Survey is the only way many landowners have of determining a fair rate to pay or charge for services such as tilling, planting, harvesting, fence installation or repair, or pesticide or fertilizer application.

“It should only take 10 or 15 minutes to complete,” said Troy Luepke, Comal County extension agent for agriculture and natural resources, “and by completing it, you’re providing a great service for other landowners who need updated information.”
