Extension Office offers summer camps on natural resources, sewing

NEW BRAUNFELS — Spaces are open for children interested in sewing or natural resources to sign up for camps offered by Comal County's office of the Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service.

At natural resources camp, participants will learn about the importance of conserving natural resources, as well as how those resources can be used responsibly through hands-on activities. The camp will be 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. Thursday, July 19, at the Extension Office, 325 Resource Drive, New Braunfels. There is no cost for attending.

At sewing camp, participants will make a variety of projects designed to teach techniques and skills, including pillows, bags with zippers, and more. The camp is open to kids ages 8-17 and will take place July 24-26 in two sessions at the Extension Office; participants will be assigned to either the morning or afternoon session depending on enrollment and availability. Registration cost is \$15.

“These camps are a great opportunity for Comal County's youngest residents to get their hands dirty, try new things and learn skills that will serve them well their entire lives,” said Connie Sheppard, extension agent for family and community health.

A third camp, focusing on LEGO robotics, is full and cannot accept additional registrations.
