Deadline for Hay Show entries is Aug. 30

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE, AUGUST 15, 2018:

NEW BRAUNFELS — Entries for the 2018 Comal County Hay Show are due to the Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service offices no later than Aug. 30.

The hay show is an annual part of the Comal County Fair. This year, the show will be Friday, Sept. 26. Local hay producers are encouraged to participate.

Competitors can deliver their hay samples to the Comal County Extension Office, 325 Resource Drive, New Braunfels, during regular office hours – 8 a.m. to noon and 1-5 p.m. Monday through Friday.

Samples can be submitted in the following categories: Bermudagrass, warm-season perennial grass, warm-season annual grass, cool-season grass and legumes.

Each sample must be submitted as follows:

- Square bale – three flakes at least 8 inches wide
- Round bale – the size of a carton of paper (12-by-18-by-9 inches), filled, stuffed and tied on the outside of the box with at least three strands of string going both ways. Untied samples will be disqualified.

American Plant Food and Producers Co-op of New Braunfels will donate one ton of ammonium sulfate fertilizer to the grand champion of the hay show.
