### **Road Department begins summer resurfacing projects**

**FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE, JUNE 14, 2019:**

*NEW BRAUNFELS* — For the 2019 paving season, Comal County road crews are scheduled to resurface roads in the following subdivisions:

- Rim Rock Ranch, east of Bulverde;
- Rolling Hills Estates, near Startzville;
- Rancho del Lago, north of FM 32 near the Hays County line; and
- Rivermont, west of Spring Branch near the Kendall County line.

Crews also plan to resurface the following major thoroughfares:

- Obst Road, along Cibolo Creek south of Bulverde;
- Hueco Springs Loop Road, northwest of New Braunfels between SH 46 and River Road;
- Fischer Store Road, from FM 484 to the Hays County line; and
- Spring Branch Road, in western Comal County between SH 46 and U.S. Highway 281.

The summer schedule is subject to change because of weather, equipment or materials issues, or unforeseen needs that crop up elsewhere in the county's road system.

Comal County maintains named roads in unincorporated areas of the county. State highways, which are numbered, are maintained by the Texas Department of Transportation, and private roads, identified by brown or red street signs, are maintained by the property owners.

“We appreciate drivers’ patience, caution and courtesy as they come across our crews this summer,” said Robert Boyd, assistant county engineer. “These projects will lengthen the lives of the roads and make them safer to drive on.”
