# Proclamation

## Naming May 2010 as "Community Action Month" in Comal County

**WHEREAS**, community action agencies were created as the Economic Opportunity Act of 1964 was signed into law; and

**WHEREAS**, community action agencies have a 45-year history of promoting self-sufficiency for the limited income; and

**WHEREAS**, community action agencies have made an essential contribution to individuals and families in Texas, by providing them with innovative and cost-effective programs; and

**WHEREAS**, community action agencies are needed as major participants in the reform of the welfare system as we know it; and


**WHEREAS**, welfare reform in Texas has benefited from the state's partnership with community action agencies; and


