Proclamation

Recognizing the Canyon Lake Noon Lions for
Forty Years of Service to Canyon Lake, Comal County, Texas

WHEREAS, the Canyon Lake Noon Lions, in Multiple District 2, District 2S3 in Texas, a member of Lions Clubs International, was formally chartered on March 21, 1977; and

WHEREAS, Lions Clubs at Canyon Lake have been in existence since 1967, beginning with the Canyon Lake Evening Club, whose members subsequently chartered the Canyon Lake Noon Lions Club; and

WHEREAS, the Canyon Lake Noon Lions Club has operated uninterrupted as the sole area Lions Club during the past forty years; and

WHEREAS, the Canyon Lake Noon Lions support the Lions International mission as "knights of the blind," doing early-childhood vision screening in elementary schools, collecting used eyeglasses for recycling, and other community health-related programs such as diabetes and hearing loss prevention and control; and

WHEREAS, the Canyon Lake Noon Lions sponsor an annual Fish Fry and Shrimpfest as their major fundraiser; and

WHEREAS, the Canyon Lake Noon Lions partnered with Lowe's Market and Brookshire Brothers in a successful environmental effort to recycle aluminum cans; and

WHEREAS, Lions provided extensive flood relief assistance to the Canyon Lake community in the 2002 Fourth of July flood; and

WHEREAS, the Canyon Lake Noon Lions were major contributors to the Community Resource and Recreation Center (CRRC) Community Pavilion, dedicated on June 29, 2014, in honor of then-Precinct 4 County Commissioner Jan Kennady; and

WHEREAS, the Canyon Lake Noon Lions continue to support the local community through local donations, an annual Christmas Parade, and sponsorship of Leo Clubs at Mountain Valley Middle School and Canyon Lake High School.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Commissioners Court of Comal County, duly convened and acting in its capacity as the governing body of Comal County, does hereby recognize March 21, 2017 as the 40th anniversary of the Canyon Lake Noon Lions and congratulate them for their continued support to the residents of Comal County.
