Proclamation

Declaring National Night Out 2017

WHEREAS, the residents of Comal County play a vital role in assisting all police agencies in the county through joint crime-, drug- and violence-prevention efforts; and

WHEREAS, police-community partnerships, neighborhood safety, awareness and cooperation are important themes of the National Night Out program; and


WHEREAS, all police agencies in Comal County have continued their commitment to excellence in service and to working together with our communities to keep them safe; and
