Proclamation

Recognizing Jacobs Creek School Teacherage as a Texas Historical Commission Recorded Texas Historical Landmark

WHEREAS, the Jacobs Creek School Teacherage, at 12794 River Road near Sattler, has been awarded a Texas Historical Commission marker designating it to be a Recorded Texas Historical Landmark and the site to be a significant part of Texas history; and

WHEREAS, area families started Jacobs Creek School in October 1867, with trustees leasing land from Oscar Friedrich for one dollar; and

WHEREAS, Carl Pantermuehl, the third teacher at the school, is credited with building the teacherage near the school in 1870, the same year he married Agnes Friedrich, the daughter of the landowner; and

WHEREAS, the one-and-a-half story log cabin is built of hand-hewn and notched Ashe Juniper with fachwerk construction; and

WHEREAS, architect Robert Story and his wife, Bess, purchased the teacherage in 1978, and with their love for historic properties restored it for their use as part of their residence; and

WHEREAS, the sponsor of the marker is Bess Story; and

WHEREAS, a marker dedication will be held at 2 p.m. Sunday, October 21, at 12794 River Road, New Braunfels, Comal County, Texas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED that the Comal County Commissioners Court, duly convened and acting in its capacity as the governing body of Comal County, and the Comal County Historical Commission wish to commend you on your work towards receiving this marker and your dedication to historical preservation and recording the history of Comal County.
