Proclamation

Recognizing Living Legend 2018 Tobin Hoffmann

WHEREAS, Tobin Carl Hoffmann's German ancestors settled New Braunfels in the 1840s, and his parents, Carroll and Helen, passed a legacy of community service to their children, who have more than honored that tradition; and

WHEREAS, for many years, the Hoffmann family has decorated Main Plaza for the Sophienburg Museum and Archives' annual July 4th celebration, and Tobin's Boy Scout Troop 133 has carried the large U.S. flag in the parade, and for years, Tobin and his wife, Judy, and their three children, Catherine, Caleb and Canaan, planted, watered and cared for the four island flowerbeds that circled the plaza until the City of New Braunfels took over; and

WHEREAS, Tobin continues to amass an amazing body of volunteer work while maintaining his career as a certified financial planner, including a remarkable 34-year perfect-attendance record at the New Braunfels Downtown Rotary, where he is a past-president, a Paul Harris Fellow and the 2007-08 Rotarian of the Year; and

WHEREAS, a member and former chair of the Greater New Braunfels Chamber of Commerce board, Tobin has been inducted into the Chamber's Hall of Honor and recognized for his commitment to Comal County youth with the chamber's President's Award; and

WHEREAS, Tobin's list of memberships and service is long: member of the Braunfels Foundation Trust and the Wurstfest Association, where he serves on the Scholarship Committee; member of the Voluntary Organizations Active in Disasters; longtime member and board member of the Sophienburg, participating significantly in the restoration of the Emmie Seele Faust Library and narrating an audio tour explaining the founding of New Braunfels; member of the City of New Braunfels Bond Advisory Committee and Downtown Advisory Board; and

WHEREAS, Tobin counts among his many honors the United Way 2018 Volunteer of the Year; the New Braunfels ISD Education Foundation's Distinguished Alumni award; the New Braunfels ISD's Silver Unicorn award; the Rosen Award from Ameritas, which is bestowed annually on someone who demonstrates both long-term success in their practice and commitment to their community and the cause of humanity; and

WHEREAS, Tobin's impact in leading and training young men to be good citizens and leaders through Boy Scouts is unrivaled, beginning as a scout himself in Troop 133, where he earned the rank of Eagle Scout in 1975 and which he and other former members rebuilt upon his return to New Braunfels in 1981, helping hundreds of boys in the subsequent decades to become Eagle Scouts, leading the Boys Scouts of America in 2007 to bestow on Tobin its highest volunteer honor, the Silver Beaver.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED that the Comal County Commissioners Court, acting in its capacity as the governing body of Comal County, does hereby recognize and commend Tobin Hoffmann for being named by the Braunfels Foundation Trust a Living Legend in Comal County.
