



DECLARATION OF DISASTER

WHEREAS, the County of Comal on the 24th day of August, 2017, has suffered widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property (or there is imminent threat of same) resulting from Hurricane Harvey, including but limited to potential flooding throughout the County and evacuations and sheltering of citizens from coastal counties, and

WHEREAS, County Judge of Comal County, Texas has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE OF Comal County, Texas:

1. That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for Comal County, Texas, pursuant to section 418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.
2. Pursuant to section 418.108(b) of the Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the Commissioners Court of Comal County, Texas.
3. Pursuant to section 418.108(c) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the County Clerk.
4. Pursuant to section 418.108(d) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the Comal County emergency management plan.
5. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
