- 1) In reviewing the Bid Documents we have observed; changes to the Bid Sheet, the inclusion of the alternative of installing Masters on Wood Poles within the flood plain, a more detailed description of requirements related to removing existing equipment and site location drawings. Were there any other significant changes to the Bid Document from the previous Bid?

**The description of changes summarized appears to address the significant changes made in the revised technical specifications.**

- 2) We assume Bid item 1 on the Bid Form Qty 1 would include the pedestal pole master and the two remotes for the site as well as any work required to remove and move equipment that would be reused for the site. Likewise for Bid item 1A we assume that it would include all the same items but with a Wood Pole Master rather than the pedestal pole. Can you confirm that this is correct? The same question would apply to items 2 and 3.

**Correct - Refer to Specifications Section 2, G.**

- 3) If our assumptions in question 2 above are correct this would mean that the total base bid will be higher than our previous bid because it will include two complete prices for the line items 1, 2 and 3. Should we provide two Total Base Bid Amounts? One for the total of 1,2,3,4,5 and 6 (Pedestal Pole Masters) and one for the total of 1A,2A,3A,4,5 and 6 (Wood Pole Masters)?
