

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR OBTAINING A DEATH CERTIFICATE

- Fees:
  - \$21.00 Certified Copy of Death Certificate (first copy)
  - \$4.00 each additional copy thereafter
- Death records are CLOSED for 25-years from the date of death [Government Code §552.115].
- Qualified applicant(s) may make application to receive a certified copy.
- The Texas Board of Health has the authority to control accessibility to Death Certificates and has adopted rules defining Qualified Applicant(s) to obtain certified copies of Death Certificate(s) [Health & Safety Code §191.051].
- A Properly Qualified Applicant is the registrant, or immediate family member either by blood, marriage or adoption, his or her guardian, or his or her legal agent or representative [Texas Administrative Code Title 25 §181.1(21)].
- Immediate Family Member is defined as registrant, his or her guardian, or the children, spouse, parents, siblings, or grandparents of the registrant Texas Administrative Code Title 25 §181.1(13)].
- Applicant is required to present a current, valid (Government issued) Photo ID with application [Texas Administrative Code Title 25 §181.1(12)].
- Persons not meeting the Qualified Applicant criteria may make application to receive “Verification of Death Facts” for \$10.00. Verification of Death Facts contains the name and date of event only.
