

COMAL COUNTY ACCOUNTABILITY COURT PROGRAM

Five-Phase Program Schedule

A. PHASE I

- Participate in Phase I for a minimum of 3 months
- Use of SCRAM device and program for a minimum of 90 days, and pay required fees (a written request for removal is required)
- Appear before the Accountability Court weekly
- Report to probation weekly
- Submit to random drug/ alcohol screens (urinalysis)
- Attend Mutual Support Group meetings at the rate of at least twice weekly and provide verification
- Granted Occupational License upon proper written request and proof of insurance.
- Ignition Interlock with Camera is required on any vehicle driven with blow schedule
- Attend groups, classes or treatment as directed (IOP)
- Random home and/or field visits
- When eligible, provide a written request to advance to Phase II

B. PHASE II

- Participate in Phase II for a minimum of 3 months
- Frequent Ignition Interlock testing/blow schedule
- Attend Mutual Support Group meetings at the rate of at least twice weekly and provide verification
- Report to probation every two weeks
- Appear before the Accountability Court every two weeks
- Continue to attend groups/classes/treatment as directed by the Court (IOP and/or Aftercare)
- Submit to random drug/alcohol screens (urinalysis)
- Random home and/or field visits
- When eligible, provide a written request to advance to Phase III

C. PHASE III

- Participate in Phase III for a minimum of 3 months
- Frequent Ignition Interlock testing/blow schedule
- Submit to random alcohol and drug/ alcohol screens (urinalysis)
- Report to probation every two weeks
- Appear before the Accountability Court every two weeks
- Attend Mutual Support Group meetings at the rate of at least twice weekly and provide verification
- Continue to attend groups/classes/treatment as directed by the Court (Aftercare)
- Random home and/or field visits
- When eligible, provide a written request to advance to Phase IV

D. PHASE IV

- Participate in Phase III for a minimum of 3 months
- Frequent Ignition Interlock testing/blow schedule
- Submit to random alcohol and drug/ alcohol screens (urinalysis)
- Report monthly to probation
- Appear monthly before the Accountability Court

- Attend Mutual Support Group meetings at the rate of at least twice weekly and provide verification
- Continue to attend groups/classes/treatment as directed by the Court (VIP and DWI Intervention)
- Opportunity for change
 - Random home and/or field visits
- When eligible, provide a written request to Graduate (Application for Commencement) and advance to Phase V

E. PHASE V

- Participate in Phase V for a minimum of 3 months
- Less Frequent Ignition Interlock testing/blow schedule
- Submit to random alcohol and drug/ alcohol screens (urinalysis)
- Report monthly to probation
- Appear every six weeks before the Accountability Court
- Attend Mutual Support Group meetings at the rate of at least twice weekly and provide verification
- Continue to attend groups/classes/treatment as directed by the Court
- Attend exit program screening
