**Standard Probation  
CONDITIONS OF COMMUNITY SUPERVISION/ADULT SUPERVISION**

In accordance with the authority conferred by the Community Supervision/Adult Probation Law of the State of Texas, you have been placed under supervision this date, \_\_\_\_\_, 20\_\_\_\_, for a period of \_\_\_\_\_ months for the offense of Driving While Intoxicated 2nd Offense (MA) by the Honorable \_\_\_\_\_, Judge, County Court at Law of Comal County, Texas. It is the order of the Court that you shall comply with the following conditions of community supervision.

- 1) Obey all orders of the Court and the instructions of the Supervision Officer;
- 2) Commit no offense against the laws of this State, of any other State, or of the United States;
- 3) Do not use or consume, in any amount, any controlled substance, narcotic or habit-forming drug, or any alcoholic beverage, unless prescribed in writing by a physician;
- 4) Avoid persons or places of disreputable or harmful character (including places where narcotic drugs, marijuana and controlled substances are present, sold or used, and where alcoholic beverages are sold, except for bona fide eating places); do not associate with persons who possess, sell, or use controlled substances or other drugs, and persons of criminal record;
- 5) Report to the Supervision Officer as often as weekly beginning this date and as directed by your Supervision Officer;
- 6) Permit the Supervision Officer to visit you at your home or elsewhere;
- 7) Obtain and keep gainful employment in a lawful occupation;
- 8) Do not change place of residence without the permission of your Comal County Supervision Officer;
- 9) Remain within \_\_\_\_\_/COMAL County, Texas during the term of supervision except by written permission of the Supervision Officer;
- 10) Support your dependents;
- 11) Pay your fine, if one be assessed, and the costs of the court in one or several sums, and make restitution or reparations in any sum that the Court shall determine to-wit \$500.00 Accountability Court Program fee payable within 4 months - before completion of Phase 1 of program) \$0.00 attorney's fees, \$\_\_\_\_\_ Restitution; \*\$4,000.00 Fine, \$\_\_\_\_\_ costs (including \$50.00 Crime Stoppers), \$0 Reimbursement Fee totaling \$\_\_\_\_\_ in payments of \$\_\_\_\_\_ plus a \$2.00 monthly Administrative Fee by the 10<sup>th</sup> of each month starting on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of \_\_\_\_\_, 20\_\_\_\_ to the Comal County Court at Law Clerk. (\*Fine suspended upon successful completion of accountability court program)
- 12) Pay \$60.00 per month probation/supervision fee to the Comal County Community Supervision and Corrections Department for \_\_\_\_\_ consecutive months by the 10th day of each month, beginning on the 10th day of \_\_\_\_\_ 20\_\_\_\_, except for months in which you are granted permission by this department to live and work outside of the State of Texas and are successfully supervised through the Interstate Compact Procedure in the receiving state.
- 13) The defendant does hereby agree that if he hereafter leaves the State of Texas without permission of the Supervision Officer, he does hereby waive extradition to the State of Texas from any jurisdiction, in or outside the United States, where he may be found, and the defendant does hereby waive any contest to any effort by any jurisdiction to return him to the State of Texas.

- 14) Submit to testing as directed by your Supervision Officer or their agent for the use or consumption of alcohol or controlled substances, daily or as otherwise instructed and pay any required fees to the CSCD including but not limited to an initial \$25.00 fee.
- 15) Perform 100 hours of Community Service Restitution (CSR) work at a minimum of 16 hours per month once initially placed with the Court Pre-Approved CSR Agency(s) and Projects(s) as directed by the CSR Program of the community Supervision and Corrections Department of Comal County, Texas. (Suspended upon completion of Accountability Court Program)

Additionally, you must abide by any further conditions marked below:

- 16) Provide verification of employment and income by the 10<sup>th</sup> day of each month to the community Supervision Officer. Provide copies of all W-2 forms, Federal Income Tax returns and all similar documents to the Community Supervision Officer by the 15<sup>th</sup> day of May of each year during the period of probation.
- 17) If the defendant is subject to deportation and is deported, do not return to the United States illegally. The defendant must report to the Comal County Community Supervision and Corrections Department by mail on or before the 10<sup>th</sup> day of each month that he resides outside of the United States and provide verification of income. If the defendant returns to the United States, defendant must report to the Comal County Community Supervisions and Corrections Department within 10 days of re-entry.
- 18) Participate in and successfully complete all phases of the Accountability Court Program. Comply with any additional program requirements and pay all required fees until discharged by the Court.
- 19) Participate in the SCRAM program for a minimum of 90 days and pay the balance for the program participation within 12 months from the placement of the monitor. Monitor cost is \$9.00 per day.
- 20) Attend and successfully complete a DWI Education/DWI Intervention Program and pay all costs as directed by your Supervision Officer within 181 days of this date.
- 21) Serve 30 days in the Comal County Jail as specified in the Commitment Order in this Cause; (as suspended as per Accountability Court)
- 22) Do not operate a motor vehicle unless it is equipped with a photo identification device that uses a deep lung breath analysis mechanism to make impractical the operation of the motor vehicle if ethyl alcohol is detected in the breath of the operator, and pay any required fees. Said device is required for the entire term of community supervision.
- 23) While serving a term of community supervision, engage the operation of the ignition interlock device causing an engine start two times daily. Unless otherwise instructed by the Court or at the direction of the Supervision Officer with Court approval, the times the engine shall be started are 10:00am and 10:00pm daily for the entire term of supervision.
- 24) Attend and successfully complete the Victim Impact Panel Program as directed by your Supervision Officer, within 181 days from this date and pay any required fees as designated by your Supervision Officer.
- 25) Submit to Alcohol/Drug evaluation and counseling as directed by your Supervision Officer, pay all costs and provide written verification of attendance to the officer within one year of this date or no later than 30 days prior to your date of discharge, whichever comes first.
- 26) Faithfully attend Recovery Works and/or Relapse Prevention Group or another alcohol/drug abuse aftercare program daily or as directed by your supervision officer, provide written verification of said attendance and pay all required fees within one year of this date or no later than 30 days prior to your date of discharge in this case, whichever comes first.

27) Attend Mutual Support Group meetings weekly or as directed by the Supervision Officer and provide written verification to the Supervision Officer.

28) Faithfully attend and successfully complete the Intensive Out-Patient treatment program for an alcohol/drug abuse problem, as designated by your supervision officer as directed and pay all required fees.

- Prepare apology letter to victim/officer herein in 90 days.
- Have no contact of any kind with the victim herein.
- Do not use a checking account during the period of probation.
- Driver's License suspension required for \_\_\_\_\_ months/years.
- Sentence to run concurrent with \_\_\_\_\_.

You are hereby advised that under the law of this State, the Court shall determine the terms and conditions of your supervision, and may at any time during the period of supervision, alter or modify the conditions of your community supervision. Pursuant to Article 42.12 Sec.10 (d) (e) and Section 21 Code of Criminal Procedure, your conditions may be modified to address any violation of any of the conditions set out above within the Community Supervision and Corrections Department Programs and Sanctions Policy, which could be up to and including a CCF. The Court also has the authority at any time during the period of your supervision to revoke your supervision for violation of any of the conditions set out above;
