
STANDING ORDER PROHIBITING ELECTRONIC RECORDINGS


The Texas Supreme Court and the Texas Court of Criminal Appeals have issued emergency orders authorizing all courts in Texas to “[a]llow or require anyone involved in any hearing, deposition, or other proceeding of any kind – including but not limited to a party, attorney, witness, or court reporter, but not including a juror – to participate remotely, such as by teleconferencing, videoconferencing, or other means.”


While the Texas Supreme Court has authorized video and telephonic hearings during this state of emergency, and while this Court will conduct video and telephonic hearings, unauthorized recording and broadcasting of court proceedings is prohibited. IT IS ORDERED that no person, other than the court reporter, may record by still photograph, audio, video or any other means, a court proceeding without the Court’s express permission. This prohibition applies to all persons, including members of the public or media viewing or listening to court proceedings.


Any person found in violation of this Order could face monetary sanction or criminal contempt. Each violation of this order could result in a fine up to \$500 and a sentence of confinement in the Comal County Jail for up to six (6) months.


