REQUESTING THE 86<sup>TH</sup> LEGISLATURE CREATE  
AN ADDITIONAL DISTRICT COURT IN COMAL COUNTY

WHEREAS, Comal County currently has four district courts, consisting of three multicounty district courts and one district court exclusive to Comal County; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Legislature last created a district court in Comal County over thirteen years ago and the court became established in 2007; and

WHEREAS, Comal County has been ranked the second fastest growing county in the nation by the U.S. Census Bureau; and

WHEREAS, the Comal County Commissioners Court recognizes the need for the creation of an additional district court to administer the existing and forecasted caseload of the Comal County judicial system as a result of significant growth within the county; and

WHEREAS, the civil and criminal filings in all Comal County courts are at their highest levels ever, without any indication of reduction in the future; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Court Administration's analysis of the current caseload for the Comal County District Courts indicates the need for and warrants an additional district court.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Commissioners Court of Comal County hereby requests State Senator Donna Campbell and State Representative Kyle Biedermann to immediately file and present Senate and House bills creating an additional district court in and for Comal County, Texas.
