**A RESOLUTION BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF COMAL COUNTY, TEXAS AUTHORIZING AWARD ACCEPTANCE UNDER THE SPECIALTY COURTS GRANT PROGRAM THROUGH THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR IN THE AMOUNT OF \$65,550.01, TO SUPPORT THE INCREASING ACCOUNTABILITY PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioners Court of Comal County finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Comal County, Texas, that the Increasing Accountability Program be operated for the 2022 Grant Year through the County Court at Law #1; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioners Court of Comal County understands that if awarded, the project period of performance will be from September 1, 2021 to August 31, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioners Court of Comal County understands that of the total project cost of \$65,550.01, 100 percent will be reimbursed with no match requirement: and

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioners Court of Comal County agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor funds, the Commissioners Court of Comal County assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioners Court of Comal County designates County Judge Sherman Krause as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Commissioners Court of Comal County approves the submission and acceptance of the grant award for the FY22 Specialty Courts Grant Program to the Office of the Governor.
