

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioners Court desires to recommend transportation improvements to roadways on the State highway system;

## Exhibit "A"

### Roadway Improvement Projects for the Alamo Area Metropolitan Planning Organization as Recommended by the Comal County Commissioners Court March 26, 2021

#### Projects Recommended:

1. FM 2252
  - a) Expand scope of existing project to increase project limits to include the FM 3009 intersection, complete roadway construction in lieu of widening, and additional retaining walls required at UPRR overpass.
2. FM 306
  - a) Pedestrian improvements along FM 306 at the Guadalupe River and the horseshoe near FM 2673.
3. SH 46
  - a) Improve intersection of SH 46 at FM 3009.
4. SH 46
  - a) Improve between FM 3159 and Bentwood Dr. to a divided 4-6 lane roadway with left/right turn lanes and signalization at all major roadway intersections.
  - b) Improve between Far Hills DR and Bulverde Rd. to a divided 4-6 lane roadway with left/right turn lanes and signalization at all major roadway intersections.
5. FM 306
  - a) Improve the intersection of FM 306 and FM 2673 as well as the approaches in between, and including, the two bridges over the Guadalupe River.
6. SH 46
  - a) Improve intersection of SH 46 at S. Cranes Mill Rd.
7. FM 1863
  - a) Improve between US 281 and the Smithson Valley Road to a divided 4-lane roadway with left/right turn lanes and signalization at all major roadway intersections.
8. FM 306
  - a) Improve between River Chase Way and the eastern Guadalupe River bridge to 4 lanes with left/right turn lanes and signalization at all major roadway intersections.

9. **FM 3009**

- a) **Provide improved shoulders.**

10. **SH 46**

- a) **Improve intersection of SH 46 at FM 311.**

11. **SH 46**

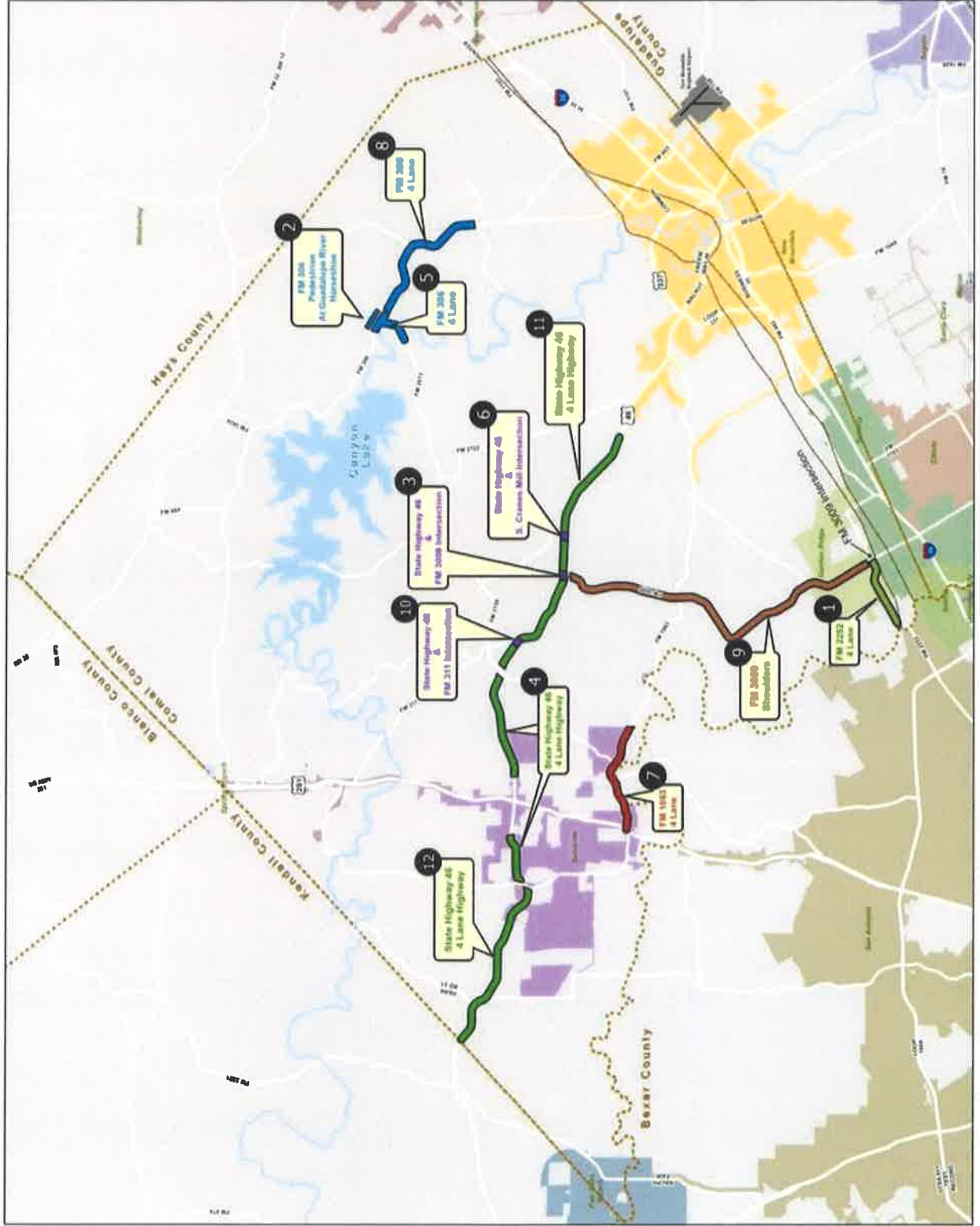
- a) **Improve between Range Rd. and FM 3159 to a divided 4-6 lane roadway with left/right turn lanes and signalization at all major roadway intersections.**

12. **SH 46**

- a) **Improve between Bulverde Road and the Kendall county line to a divided 4-lane roadway with left/right turn lanes and signalization at all major roadway intersections.**

Judge and Commissioners:

The Alamo Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) has issued an agency call for Surface Transportation Block Grant and Transportation Alternatives Program funded projects for the development of the FY 2023-2026 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP).

The County Engineer's Office has visited with the members of the Commissioners Court to assemble a list of recommended highway improvement projects for the MPO's call for projects. The attached draft resolution includes a list of these recommended projects. In addition, please find attached is a draft map showing the location of the projects within Comal County. The County Engineer's Office has placed priorities on these projects. Clearly, the Commissioners Court may adjust these priorities when this resolution is considered.

Please note that all of these proposed projects are within the TxDOT highway system. Therefore, the County will be requesting that TxDOT evaluate these projects and submit the appropriate projects to the MPO for possible inclusion into their FY 2023-2026 Transportation Improvement Program call for projects.

The MPO's deadline for agency's wishing to submit recommended projects is April 1, 2021. We intend to place this resolution on the March 26, 2021 Commissioners Court agenda for consideration and approval.
