IN THE COMMISSIONERS COURT

**Recognizing the 175th Anniversary of the Creation of Comal County, Texas**

**WHEREAS**, the early inhabitants of what is now Comal County were primarily Tonkawa and Waco Indians; and

**WHEREAS**, a village of some 500 Tonkawas on the Guadalupe River initially welcomed German visitors; and

**WHEREAS**, permanent settlement of this area began in 1845 when Prince Carl of Solms-Braunfels purchased 1,265 acres of land from Maria Antonia Veramendi Garza for \$1,112 , including the Comal River and the present site of New Braunfels; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 24, 1846, the Texas Legislature created Comal County from the Eighth Precinct of Bexar County and made New Braunfels the County Seat; and

**WHEREAS**, in succeeding years, thousands of Germans, Americans, and immigrants from many other countries were attracted to the rich farm and ranch land around New Braunfels; and

**WHEREAS**, because of its character, hill-country charm, and welcoming environment Comal County has become one of the fastest growing counties in the country; and

**WHEREAS**, the industrious and hardworking people of Comal County have made invaluable contributions to the County's growth, development and advancement.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Commissioners Court of Comal County, Texas, duly convened and acting in its capacity as the governing body of Comal County recognizes and congratulates Comal County and its citizens on this 175<sup>th</sup> anniversary; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that Comal County calls upon all individuals, businesses, and organizations to observe the 175<sup>th</sup> anniversary of our county with appropriate ceremonies, activities, and events that support this milestone and this great community.
