ORDER GRANTING DISCRETIONARY EXEMPTION FROM SECTION 262.023 OF THE TEXAS LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE TO PROTECT THE PUBLIC HEALTH OR SAFETY OF THE RESIDENTS OF THE COUNTY

WHEREAS, Section 262.023 of the Texas Local Government Code requires the Commissioners Court to comply with competitive bidding procedures for purchase of one or more items under a contract that will require an expenditure exceeding \$50,000; and

WHEREAS, Section 262.024(a)(2) of the Texas Local Government Code authorizes the Commissioners Court to grant an exemption for "an item necessary to preserve or protect the public health or safety of the residents of the county"; and

WHEREAS, Comal County wishes to contract with Austin Wood Recycling for the procurement of mulching services; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT FOR COMAL COUNTY THAT: The provisions of Texas Local Government Code §262.024(a)(2) shall apply to exempt the procurement with Austin Wood Recycling for the procurement of mulching services from the competitive procurement procedures because it qualifies as an item needed to preserve or protect the public health or safety of the residents of the county.
