A RESOLUTION BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF COMAL COUNTY, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION UNDER THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE PROGRAM (CJP) THROUGH THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR TO SUPPORT THE COMPUTER FORENSIC RECOVERY OF EVIDENCE PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Comal County finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Comal County, Texas, that the Computer Forensic Recovery of Evidence Project be operated for the 2023 Grant Year through the Office of the Sheriff; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Comal County understands that if awarded, the project period of performance will be from October 1, 2022 to September 30, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Comal County is committed to provide all applicable match funds for the said project as required by the Criminal Justice Program; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Comal County agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor funds, the Commissioners Court of Comal County assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Comal County designates County Judge, Sherman Krause, as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Commissioners Court of Comal County approves submission of the grant application for the FY23 Criminal Justice Program to the Office of the Governor.
