DETERMINING VOTES CAST TO ELECT DIRECTORS FOR THE
COMAL APPRAISAL DISTRICT BOARD OF DIRECTORS FOR YEARS 2025 AND
2025-2027

WHEREAS, Section 6.03(k), of the Texas Property Tax Code requires that each taxing unit entitled to vote shall determine its vote by resolution and submit that vote to the Chief Appraiser of the Comal Appraisal District by December 15, 2024; and

WHEREAS, Section 6.03(k-1), [effective on January 01, 2022] of the Texas Property Tax Code applies only to an appraisal district established in a county with a population of 120,000 or more. The governing body of each taxing unit entitled to cast at least five percent of the total votes must determine its vote by resolution adopted at the first or second open meeting of the governing body that is held after the date the chief appraiser delivers the ballot to the presiding officer of the governing body. The governing body must submit its vote to the chief appraiser not later than the third day following the date the resolution is adopted.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Comal County Commissioners Court submits the Official Ballot, attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes, as issued by the Chief Appraiser, stating the vote for candidates for the election of the Board of Directors for the Comal Appraisal District.

*WHEREAS, Section 6.03(k-1), This subsection applies only to an appraisal district established in a county with a population of 120,000 or more. The governing body of each taxing unit entitled to cast at least five percent of the total votes must determine its vote by resolution adopted at the first or second open meeting of the governing body that is held after the date the chief appraiser delivers the ballot to the presiding officer of the governing body. The governing body must submit its vote to the chief appraiser not later than the third day following the date the resolution is adopted.

RE: 2025 and 2025-2027 Comal Appraisal District Board of Directors Election Ballot

Dear Judge Krause:

Enclosed is the 2025 and 2025-2027 Board of Directors ballot for Comal County. As per Section 6.03(d) of the Texas Property Tax Code, *"The voting entitlement of a taxing unit that is entitled to vote for directors is determined by dividing the total dollar amount of property taxes imposed in the district by the taxing unit for the preceding tax year by the sum of the total dollar amount of property taxes imposed in the district for that year by each taxing unit that is entitled to vote, by multiplying the quotient by 1,000, and by rounding the product to the nearest whole number. That number is multiplied by the number of directorships to be filled. A taxing unit participating in two or more districts is entitled to vote in each district in which it participates, but only the taxes imposed in a district are used to calculate voting entitlement in that district."*

**WHEREAS, Section 6.03(k-1), "This subsection applies only to an appraisal district established in a county with a population of 120,000 or more. The governing body of each taxing unit entitled to cast at least five percent of the total votes must determine its vote by resolution adopted at the first or second open meeting of the governing body that is held after the date the chief appraiser delivers the ballot to the presiding officer of the governing body. The governing body must submit its vote to the chief appraiser not later than the third day following the date the resolution is adopted."*

Also, Section 6.03(k) of the Texas Property Tax Code requires that *"The governing body of each taxing unit entitled to vote shall determine its vote by resolution and submit it to the chief appraiser before December 15."* **Therefore please submit results of that vote to the Chief Appraiser of the Comal Appraisal District by December 15, 2024 on the enclosed ballot and resolution document.**

In calculating this year's votes, it is determined that Comal County has **973 votes** to cast in this election. Since this constitutes 19.5% of the votes, please refer to Section 6.03(k-1) above.
