Election Day for constitutional amendments is Tuesday

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE, NOVEMBER 2, 2017:

NEW BRAUNFELS — Election Day is Tuesday for seven proposed amendments to the Texas Constitution. Polls in Comal County will be open from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

As of Wednesday, 997 Comal County residents had voted early or sent in ballots by mail, amounting to about 1 percent of the county's 93,945 registered voters.

Because amendment elections tend to experience lower turnout, the Comal County Elections Office has consolidated polling places for Election Day. The polling places and the voting precincts they will serve are:

- 403: North Shore United Methodist Church, 23880 N. Cranes Mill Road, Canyon Lake
- 404, 406: Christ Presbyterian Church, 1620 Common St., New Braunfels
