Culvert work to require three-week Tanglewood Trail closure

NEW BRAUNFELS — Comal County road crews will close Tanglewood Trail for three weeks beginning Wednesday to repair a culvert where the road crosses Schultz Creek.

The culvert funnels Schultz Creek underneath Tanglewood and into an unnamed pond east of the road. The corrugated metal pipe is constantly underwater, said Assistant County Engineer David Vollbrecht, and as a result has begun to rust and disintegrate, causing the road it supports to settle.

The closure is in the 2900 block of Tanglewood Trail, which loops through the Cypress Cove subdivision between FM 306 and Canyon Lake. Crews will replace the metal pipe with two polypropylene pipes after setting up a temporary dam in the pond to divert water away from the culvert. Work on the pond began Monday.

The road is scheduled to reopen Wednesday, Nov. 1.
