Applications open for award-winning University of County Government classes

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE, JANUARY 5, 2017:

NEW BRAUNFELS — Applications are open for Comal County’s sixth annual University of County Government, an award-winning, free 10-week course that introduces attendees to the role and function of county government..

The classes occur each Tuesday from 6-9 p.m., starting March 13 and ending with graduation May 15 and recognition at the subsequent Commissioners Court meeting, May 17.

All county residents are eligible to apply for the class, which is limited to 30 members. Applications are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.

The class meets primarily in the historic Comal County Courthouse, with roughly half of the sessions off site, including tours of the jail, Extension Office and new Comal County Elections Center.

“This is an exciting and unique opportunity for county residents to go straight to the source and learn how their county government functions and how their tax dollars are spent,” said County Judge Sherman Krause.

The program won a Best Practices award from the Texas Association of Counties in 2016. Applications for the 2018 University of County Government are available at comalcountytexas.com/ucg.
