Extension Office offers rain barrel workshop

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE, AUGUST 7, 2019:

NEW BRAUNFELS — Rain might still seem far away, but the Comal County office of the Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service will teach interested county residents how to catch and store rainwater once it starts falling again.

The make-and-take workshop will be from 9 a.m. to noon Saturday, Aug. 17, at the county's Extension Office, 325 Resource Drive, New Braunfels.

“Every student will leave with a rain barrel they’ve helped make,” said Troy Luepke, Comal County extension agent for agriculture and natural resources, who will be teaching the class. “It’s more important than ever to be good stewards of our water resources, and learning how to make your own rain barrels is a great way to conserve water and keep your yard and garden beautiful all year long.”

The cost is \$50 per student to cover the cost of their rain barrel. Additional rain barrels are \$40 each. Students must RSVP to the Extension Office by Friday, Aug. 9. To register or get more information, call 830-620-3440 or email comal-tx@ag.tamu.edu.
