### **Fall gardening the focus of Aug. 28 class**

*NEW BRAUNFELS* — Believe it or not, cooler weather is coming – and with it the need to prepare for fall gardening.

Comal Master Gardeners and the Comal County office of the Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service will host a class on fall gardening as part of their monthly Wednesdays in the Garden series.

“The Master Gardeners put on a great session each month in our demonstration garden to help local residents maximize their success with their own gardens,” said Connie Sheppard, extension agent for family and community health. “August and September are when it’s time to prepare garden beds for fall veggies such as broccoli, cabbage and kale, so this class will be really helpful for gardeners getting ready for fall.”

Wednesdays in the Garden takes place each month at the Extension Office demonstration garden, 325 Resource Drive, New Braunfels. The fall gardening session will be 9-10 a.m. Aug. 28. There is no charge, and no RSVP is needed; attendees are invited to simply show up.

Master Gardeners Betty Keese and Keith Tunnell will teach the class, which also counts for an hour of continuing education credit for Comal Master Gardeners who participate.

- Dec. 11: Fruit and nut crops
