DIY Saturday to focus on fall gardening

NOTE: This event is different from the Wednesdays in the Garden class on fall gardening hosted by Comal Master Gardeners on Aug. 28.

NEW BRAUNFELS — The Comal County office of the Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service's next DIY Saturday class will teach students how to prepare their gardens for fall.

Troy Luepke, extension agent for agriculture and natural resources, will provide tips and tricks for making your garden successful as you head toward winter harvesting.

The class will be 9-11 a.m. Sept. 14 at the county's Extension Office, 325 Resource Drive, New Braunfels. The cost of the class is \$15 per student.

“We’ll go over what vegetables we start planting this time of year,” Luepke said. “We’ll also talk about how to prepare garden beds and how to maintain your lawn and landscaping.”

Planting for fall usually takes place in late September or early October, he said, with preparation beginning in August and harvest beginning around Thanksgiving and continuing through the new year.

Attendees can register for the classes and get more information by calling 830-620-3440. The class requires a minimum size, so students are encouraged to call ahead to make sure it will still take place.
