Election Day for constitutional amendments is Tuesday

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE, NOVEMBER 1, 2019:

NEW BRAUNFELS — Election Day is Tuesday for 10 proposed amendments to the Texas Constitution. Thirteen countywide vote centers in Comal County will be open from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

As of Thursday, 5,619 Comal County residents had voted early or sent in ballots by mail, amounting to about 5.4 percent of the county's 103,866 registered voters.

For the first time, Comal County voters can cast Election Day ballots at any open vote center, regardless of their home address. Those vote centers, arranged by region in the county, are:
