DIY Saturday to focus on quick breads

NEW BRAUNFELS — Residents looking for tips and tricks for making delicious breads and cakes without the time and hassle of using yeast are invited to attend the Comal County Extension Office's next DIY Saturday, which will focus on quick breads.

Jymann Davis, extension agent for family and community health with the Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service in Comal County, will provide recipes and pointers – and tasting will be involved.

The class will be 9-11 a.m. Feb. 8 at the county's Extension Office, 325 Resource Drive, New Braunfels. The cost of the class is \$15 per student.

“Winter is a great time for baking, and it doesn't have to be a daylong process,” Davis said. “Anyone can do it, and we'll show you how to bake delicious breads and cakes without breaking your schedule or your budget.”

Attendees can register for the classes and get more information by calling 830-620-3440. The class requires a minimum size, so students are encouraged to call ahead to make sure it will still take place.

DIY Saturday is a monthly series of classes organized by the Comal County office of the Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service and designed to provide homeowners, backyard gardeners, homemakers, educators and farmers do-it-yourself learning opportunities.
