Comal County confirms three more COVID-19 cases, total of 21

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE, APRIL 4, 2020:

NEW BRAUNFELS — Comal County has confirmed another three additional cases of COVID-19 for a total of 21, the third consecutive day of three new cases confirmed.

One is from New Braunfels, one is from north of Canyon Lake and one is from the Smithson Valley area near Bulverde. Two of the patients – one in their 30s and one in their 70s – are self-quarantined, while one in their 40s is hospitalized. At least two of the cases are considered community transmission.

As of Saturday morning, Comal County’s Office of Public Health has received reports of the following test information:

- 225 tests conducted
- 21 positive tests
- 150 negative tests
- 54 results still pending
