Three new COVID-19 cases confirmed in Comal County

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE, APRIL 10, 2020:

NEW BRAUNFELS — Comal County has confirmed three new cases of COVID-19, bringing the total in the county to 37.

The cases are north of Canyon Lake, south of Canyon Lake and in the Spring Branch area. One patient is in their 40s and two in their 60s. All are home-isolated.

As of Thursday night, Comal County's Office of Public Health has received reports of the following test information:

- 376 tests conducted
- 37 positive tests
- 259 negative tests
- 80 results still pending

Of the 37 confirmed COVID-19 cases in Comal County, the location breakdown is:

- 12 from New Braunfels or the immediate area
- 7 from the Bulverde area
- 5 from eastern Comal County
- 4 from north of Canyon Lake
- 3 from south of Canyon Lake
- 2 from Fair Oaks Ranch
- 2 from the Spring Branch area
- 1 from central Comal County
- 1 from southwest Comal County
