Comal County confirms 39th COVID-19 case

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE, APRIL 14, 2020:

NEW BRAUNFELS — Comal County on Tuesday confirmed two new COVID-19 cases while removing a Kendall County case, bringing Comal County's total to 39.

The patients are a Garden Ridge resident in their 60s, the first case in the city, and a person in their 40s from southwest Comal County. Both are home-isolated.

Upon further investigation of the case reported yesterday, the Office of Public Health learned the patient actually lives in Kendall County.

In addition, three more COVID-19 patients were listed as recovered based on guidelines from the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, for a total of 19. With six deaths, the total number of active COVID-19 cases in Comal County is 14.

As of Tuesday morning, Comal County's Office of Public Health has received reports of the following test information:

- 441 tests conducted
- 39 positive tests
- 332 negative tests
- 70 results still pending

Of the 39 confirmed COVID-19 cases in Comal County, the location breakdown is:

- 12 from New Braunfels or the immediate area
- 7 from the Bulverde area
- 5 from eastern Comal County
- 4 from north of Canyon Lake
- 3 from south of Canyon Lake
- 2 from Fair Oaks Ranch
- 2 from the Spring Branch area
- 2 from southwest Comal County

- 1 from Garden Ridge
- 1 from central Comal County
