Comal County confirms two more COVID-19 cases, total of 47

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE, APRIL 22, 2020:

NEW BRAUNFELS — Comal County on Tuesday confirmed two new COVID-19 cases for a total of 47.

The patients are New Braunfels residents in their 40s and 50s. Both live in households with previously confirmed COVID-19 patients, and they are self-isolating.

Also, the county confirmed the recovery of two more patients, bringing the total to 34. With six deaths, seven cases remain active among county residents, two of them hospitalized and the rest self-isolating at home.

As of Wednesday morning, the Office of Public Health has received reports of the following test information:

- 606 tests conducted
- 47 positive tests
- 533 negative tests
- 26 results still pending

Of the 47 confirmed COVID-19 cases in Comal County, the location breakdown is:

- 16 from New Braunfels or the immediate area
- 8 from the Bulverde area
- 5 from eastern Comal County
- 4 from north of Canyon Lake
- 3 from south of Canyon Lake
- 3 from Garden Ridge
- 3 from the Spring Branch area
- 2 from Fair Oaks Ranch
- 2 from southwest Comal County
- 1 from central Comal County
