Comal County confirms three new COVID-19 cases, total of 52

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE, APRIL 28, 2020:

NEW BRAUNFELS — Comal County on Monday confirmed three more cases of COVID-19, for a total of 52.

The patients are from New Braunfels, Bulverde and the north side of Canyon Lake, and are in their 20s, 30s and 50s. All are self-isolating.

The county also confirmed one more recovered patient, bringing the total to 36. With six deaths, that leaves 10 active cases, of which three are hospitalized with the rest isolating at home.

Testing sites open for appointments

Today opens the registration window for residents wishing to receive a free COVID-19 test at a drive-through site run by the Texas Division of Emergency Management and Texas Department of State Health Services in coordination with Comal County and Comal Independent School District.

Anyone seeking a test can visit www.txcovidtest.org or call 512-883-2400 to receive a screening and make an appointment for the site, which is at Canyon High School, 1510 IH-35, New Braunfels. Those with an appointment should enter the parking lot from FM 1101.

Testing also remains available at a local drive-through site operated by private physicians in coordination with Comal County, the City of New Braunfels and other agencies. To make an appointment at that site, residents should call 830-312-7980.

Comal County data

As of Tuesday morning, the Comal County Office of Public Health has received reports of the following test information:

- 751 tests conducted
- 52 positive tests

- 672 negative tests
- 27 results still pending

Of the 52 confirmed COVID-19 cases in Comal County, the location breakdown is:

- 19 from New Braunfels or the immediate area
- 9 from the Bulverde area
- 5 from eastern Comal County
- 5 from north of Canyon Lake
- 3 from south of Canyon Lake
- 3 from Garden Ridge
- 3 from the Spring Branch area
- 2 from Fair Oaks Ranch
- 2 from southwest Comal County
- 1 from central Comal County
