Comal County reports 34 COVID-19 cases; two deaths; 33 recoveries

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: February 4, 2021:

NEW BRAUNFELS — Comal County is reporting 34 additional cases of COVID-19 for a total of 8,329 cases.

11 are confirmed cases. 23 are probable cases.

Comal County Public Health Department also confirms the deaths of two more Comal County residents.

- A New Braunfels woman in her 80s on 2/2/2021 and
- A Southern Comal County man in his 70s on 1/14/2021 at a San Antonio hospital

The total number of deceased is now 259.

The County has 628 active confirmed and probable COVID-19 cases.
Of those, 63 are hospitalized today.

There are an additional 33 COVID-19 recoveries reported today in Comal County.
The total recovered is 7,442.

On Thursday, Comal County hospitals reported caring for 52 COVID-19 patients; of those, 27 are in intensive care and 18 are on ventilators. Not all of these patients are necessarily county residents; likewise, not all county residents hospitalized with COVID-19 are in Comal County hospitals.

TSA P percentage today is 19.01%.

As of Thursday morning, Public Health has received reports of the following test information:

- 62,925 tests conducted
- 4,369 confirmed cases
- 3,944 probable cases
- 16 suspect cases.

The seven-day Molecular positivity rate for Thursday in Comal County is 27.45%.

The seven-day Antigen positivity rate for Thursday in Comal County is 4.95%.

Of the 8,329 confirmed and probable COVID-19 cases in Comal County, the location breakdown is:

Residents wishing to be tested for COVID-19 can call the County's dedicated hotline, 830-221-1120, between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. Monday through Friday to schedule an appointment.

Testing is only done on Tuesday and Friday, and you must have an appointment.

The Comal County Health Department is closed today, February 4. All staff are working at today's vaccine clinic.

The Comal County COVID-19 Vaccine Standby List is now full and closed.

Residents interested in receiving a COVID-19 vaccine, who meet criteria in Phase 1A and Phase 1B of the State of Texas vaccination plan, can check the County's website and Facebook page for information on when that Standby List will reopen for registration.

Vaccines will be distributed to the public as they are received by Comal County and according to all state distribution guidelines.

Probable case definition

“Probable case” is a category established by the Texas Department of State Health Services to describe those who do not have a positive PCR test for COVID-19 but meet two of the following three criteria:

- Meets clinical criteria AND epidemiologic linkage with no confirmatory laboratory testing performed for SARS-CoV-2.
- Meets presumptive* laboratory evidence.
 - Presumptive* laboratory evidence:
 - Detection of SARS-CoV-2 by antigen test in a respiratory specimen
- Meets vital records criteria with no confirmatory laboratory evidence for SARS-CoV-2.

A probable case is treated identically to a confirmed case and counts toward the County’s positivity rate and total case tally.

Suspect case definition

A “Suspect case” meets supportive laboratory evidence with no prior history of being a confirmed or probable case. It is also counted towards the total case tally.

Supportive Laboratory Evidence means:

- **Detection of specific antibody in serum, plasma, or whole blood**
- **Detection of specific antigen by immunocytochemistry in an autopsy specimen.**
