Comal County reports 108 new COVID-19 cases; two deaths

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: August 13, 2021:

NEW BRAUNFELS — Comal County reports 108 new COVID-19 cases today, bringing the County total to 13,911. 72 are confirmed cases, and 35 are probable cases.

Public Health also confirms the deaths of two Comal County residents:

- Spring Branch man in his 50's passed away on August 8 at a San Antonio hospital.
- New Braunfels woman in her 70's passed away on August 11 at her home.

The total number of deceased is now 350.

There are 1,344 active confirmed and probable cases in the County today.

Of those, 36 are hospitalized.

There are 68 COVID-19 recoveries to report today.

The total recovered is 12,217.

On Friday, Comal County hospitals reported caring for 88 COVID-19 patients; of those, 17 are in intensive care and nine are on ventilators. Approximately 96% of these patients are unvaccinated. Not all of these patients are necessarily county residents; likewise, not all county residents hospitalized with COVID-19 are in Comal County hospitals.

Today's TSA P percentage is 18.51 %.

Comal County Public Health Department is administering Moderna COVID-19 vaccines for those 18 and older as well as Pfizer vaccines for anyone 12 years old and older.

As of Friday morning, Public Health has received reports of the following test information:

- 133,226 tests conducted
- 7,654 confirmed cases
- 6,233 probable cases
- 24 suspect cases

The seven-day Molecular positivity rate for Friday in Comal County is 13.78 %.

The seven-day Antigen positivity rate for Friday in Comal County is 14.37 %.

Of the 13,911 confirmed and probable COVID-19 cases in Comal County, the location breakdown is:

Probable case definition

“Probable case” is a category established by the Texas Department of State Health Services to describe those who do not have a positive PCR test for COVID-19 but meet two of the following three criteria:

- Meets clinical criteria AND epidemiologic linkage with no confirmatory laboratory testing performed for SARS-CoV-2.
- Meets presumptive* laboratory evidence.
 - Presumptive* laboratory evidence:
 - Detection of SARS-CoV-2 by antigen test in a respiratory specimen
- Meets vital records criteria with no confirmatory laboratory evidence for SARS-CoV-2.

A probable case is treated identically to a confirmed case and counts toward the County’s positivity rate and total case tally.

Suspect case definition

A “Suspect case” meets supportive laboratory evidence with no prior history of being a confirmed or probable case. It is also counted towards the total case tally.

Supportive Laboratory Evidence means:

- **Detection of specific antibody in serum, plasma, or whole blood**
- **Detection of specific antigen by immunocytochemistry in an autopsy specimen.**
