### Comal County reports 25 new COVID-19 cases

**FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: November 5, 2021:**

*NEW BRAUNFELS*— Comal County reports 25 new COVID-19 cases today, bringing the County total to 19,662. The total number of deceased is 455.

On Friday, Comal County hospitals reported caring for 12 COVID-19 patients; of those, two are in intensive care and two are on ventilators.

Approximately 100 % of these patients are unvaccinated.

Not all COVID positive patients hospitalized in Comal County are necessarily county residents.

The percentage of fully vaccinated was previously calculated on the number of residents who are 12 years of age and older. However, the percentage now includes residents 5 years of age and older starting today, which brought down the percentage.

**Comal County Public Health Department is administering Moderna COVID-19 vaccines for those 18 and older and Pfizer vaccines for anyone 12 years old and older. Once Public Health receives a standing order from the Public Health Authority for Region 8, our clinic will also have vaccines available for the 5+ age group.**

**Those who are moderately to severely immunocompromised and qualify for a 3<sup>rd</sup> dose or a booster can also call to schedule an appointment for a vaccine.**
